## Design

In partnership with the Business Improvement District #1 (BID #1) we accepted \$169,000 in grant funding. The funding was used to plant/install and maintain flower baskets and flower beds in the downtown district as well as install and store Christmas Decorations on D and Broad Streets as well as 11 Christmas trees downtown. A huge thanks goes to Siffring Landscape and Garden Center and the Parks & Recreation Department for installing, taking down, and storing the decorations.

MainStreet of Fremont also paid for over 40 new banners to be designed and printed for our downtown light poles. The Fremont & Dodge County Convention & Visitors Bureau sponsored a portion of this project and the BID #1 paid the Street Department for installation of them.





## MainStreet Mingles

Entrepreneurship is a unique experience. We believe connecting entrepreneurs with each other will foster a community of growth, mindsets that are focused on problem-solving, and breed encouragement. Overall, the goal of these meetings is to create a space for established and aspiring entrepreneurs to help them thrive!

This program is born out of a pilot program from Main Street America. They awarded communities \$3,000 in grant funding in partnership with the Kauffman Foundation.

Once a month we invite entrepreneurs to join us to meet with other Fremont area entrepreneurs (established and aspiring) to discuss milestones, detours, and roadblocks! These sessions will last about an hour with an additional half hour at the end of each session for networking opportunities.

We provide resources, ideas, and small business support. Topics and speakers are suggested by attendees. This program is something we are creating with entrepreneurs, not for them.

We meet monthly on the first Wednesday of the month. We started at the Fremont Area Art Association and have now begun rotating to different businesses.
